Sub: Expansion by addition of 1 X 80MW and 1 X 160MW coal based thermal power plant at village Periyaobulapuram, Papankuppam village-Gummidipoondi taluk – Thiruvallore district – Environmental Clearance – Compliance report for EC condition no.2 – reg.

Ref: 1. J-13012/111/2009-IA.II (T)

Condition: The project proponent shall take up the matter for transportation of coal by rail with the Railways. Progress made in this regard shall be submitted to the Regional Office of the Ministry from time to time.

We had moved a rake from Talcher to Elavur siding (6 KM away from the project site) in the month of November 2010. The rake carried 3985 MT of Indian coal. It could not be unloaded as the Siding land was fully encroached at Elavur and Gummidipoondi station.

As a result of the above we were left with no alternatives but to send the rakes back without unloading the coal. The Railways informed that they will try and resolve the issue.
