SRM Global Hospitals restores urinary function on high-risk cardiac patient

Chennai, Nov 14:

SRM Global Hospitals successfully restored urinary function in a 74-year-old male patient from Iraq who was suffering from obstructive urinary symptoms caused by Benign Prostatic Enlargement (BPE), a non-cancerous increase in the size of the prostate gland that commonly affects elderly men. Taking into account the patient's severe coronary artery disease and his dependence on blood-thinning medication, the urology team opted for advanced holmium laser technology for the removal of the enlarged prostate tissue, thereby avoiding the risks associated with conventional invasive surgical procedures.

The procedure, known as Holmium Laser Enucleation of the Prostate (HoLEP), is an advanced, minimally invasive laser surgery technique. Unlike Transurethral Resection of the Prostate (TURP), which is the conventional gold standard, HoLEP offers significant advantages, including minimal



bleeding, shorter hospital stay, and faster recovery.

The surgical team was led by Dr. Anand Krishnamoorthy and Dr. M. Deepak, Senior Consultant Urologists, supported

by Dr. Varun C., Senior Consultant Anaesthetist. Dr. T. R. Muralidharan, Cardiologist, conducted the pre-surgical cardiac evaluation and formulated the cardiac management plan.

In his comments, Dr. Anand Krishnamoorthy said, "The patient from Iraq arrived with severe urinary issues. Tests showed elevated PSA levels, prompting an MRI and biopsy that confirmed benign prostate enlargement, ruling out cancer. During pre-surgical evaluation, we found severe cardiac blockages. Although cardiac intervention was advised first, the patient wished to proceed with prostate surgery so he could resume prayers without urinary difficulty. With careful pre-surgical preparation and advanced cardiac monitoring, we safely performed Holmium Laser Enucleation of the Prostate (HoLEP). The minimally invasive laser procedure allowed precise tissue removal with minimal bleeding and a fast recovery. The patient responded well, was discharged in stable condition, and remains symptom-free under regular follow-up."

Vellore Collector's art initiative to prevent child marriage

Subbulakshmi inaugurates initiative

Vellore, Nov. 14: Vellore District Collector Subbulakshmi inaugurated an awareness art programme at the Old Bus Stand in Vellore to prevent child marriage.

The event was organised by the Department of Social Welfare and Women's Rights as part

of the "Let's Protect Girl Children, Let's Educate Girl Children" scheme.

In Vellore district, awareness campaigns will be conducted through the Saaral art troupe in 10 villages where child marriages are reported more frequently. These include Thattapara, Bharadarami,

and Kallappadi in Gudiyatham taluk; Sathgar, Aravalur, and Pathalappali in Pembabut taluk; and Odugalur, Chinnappalikipam, and Peenchantam in Anaicut taluk.

Authorities emphasized that supporting or organising child marriage is a punishable offence. The public can report incidents of child marriage by calling the helpline 1098 or 181. Those involved in conducting or supporting child marriages may face two years of imprisonment, a

fine of ₹1 lakh, or both. Collector Subbulakshmi distributed awareness pamphlets against child marriage to the public. She also instructed officials to distribute these pamphlets in the rural areas where the art programmes will be conducted.

The event was attended by Vellore MLA P. Karthikeyan, City Mayor Sujatha Anandakumar, 2nd Zone Committee Chairman R. Narendra, District Social Welfare Officer Uma, and several others.
